We are looking to appoint an enthusiastic and motivated person to join our busy team. If you are passionate about supporting unpaid family Carers then this opportunity could be for you.

The role involves:

- Enhancing links within a Hospital setting.
- Ensure family carers are supported and have assisted sign posting to relevant services and to ensure signposting is followed up after discharge.
- To work seamlessly with the Carers service GP Link worker.
- To ensure hospital information displays are kept up to date.
- To work alongside PALS and SATH teams to ensure effective support is in place for family / unpaid carers.
- To identify new carers on admission and discharge via building links on wards and in waiting areas.
- To support family carers planning for discharge.
- To complete Carers Assessments and reviews both in hospital and in the community.
- To build stronger links with partner hospital: PRH, RSH, RJAH and Redwoods, to support Telford based family carers and those they care for.

The successful candidate will be required to undertake Enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service check, and as the position requires the post holder to work in contact with vulnerable adults, Telford & Wrekin CVS is entitled to ask exempted questions under the provisions of the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974 Exemptions Order 1975 and will require an Enhanced Disclosure from the Disclosure and Barring Service before any appointment can be confirmed.
